ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Water System Improvements** project will be received by the **Central Hampshire Public Service District** at their office located at **18540 Northwestern Pike, Augusta, WV 26704**, until **2:00 PM** local time on **May 20, 2019**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

Separate Bids will be received for Contract No. 1 – Green Spring Water Treatment Plant Improvements and Contract No. 2 – Springfield Rehabilitation. The method of bidding will be as follows:

CONTRACT #1 – Green Spring Water Treatment Plant Improvements:

Lump Sum to construct the Green Spring Water Treatment Plant Improvements, consisting of all work necessary to construct improvements to an existing water filtration plant including: constructing a concrete masonry unit (CMU) addition with wooden trusses and metal roof to the existing building including concrete clearwell with hdpe baffles, precast concrete floor, pump hoist and trolley, steel platform with aluminum deck and stairs; providing water analysis equipment, metering pumps, interior piping, site piping, miscellaneous electrical work, cellular SCDA and telemetry system improvements; providing restroom facilities, 1,000 gallon sewage holding tank; removing and reinstalling the existing high service pumps, providing new high service pump and filter feed pump control panels with VFDs; site work including gravel parking area, fence relocation and other incidental work required for a complete operating water treatment plant.

CONTRACT #2 – Springfield Rehabilitation:

Contract to provide and install 100 LF 12 inch PVC Detention Main; 13,775 LF PVC 6 inch waterline; 805 LF 2 inch PVC waterline; 38 gate valves; 5 fire hydrants; 375 LF horizontal directional drilling; 442 LF highway boring; 130 LF Stream Crossing; 145 Service Reconnections; 1 booster station rehab; 1 Raven Rock Water Treatment Plant rehab; and other work required to provide the complete system improvements project.

If Contractor intends to let any subcontractors for a portion of the work, Contractor shall take affirmative steps to assure that small, minority and women’s businesses are used when possible as sources of supplies, equipment, construction, and services. Affirmative steps shall consist of: (1) including qualified small, minority and women’s businesses are used when possible as sources of supplies, equipment, construction, and services; (2) assuring that small, minority and women’s businesses are solicited whenever they are potential sources; (3) dividing total requirements when economically feasible, into small tasks or quantities to permit maximum participation of small, minority and women’s businesses; (4) establishing delivery schedules, where the requirements of the work permit, which will encourage participation by small, minority and women’s businesses; (5) using the services and assistance of the Small Business Administration and the Minority Business Development Agency of the U.S. Department of Commerce; (6) requiring each party to a subcontract to take the affirmative steps of this section; and (7) Contractor is encouraged to procure goods and services from labor surplus area firms.

By the submission of its bid, the bidder, offer or, applicant, or subcontractor certifies that he does not maintain or provide for his employees any segregated facilities at any of his establishments, and that he does not permit his employees to perform their services at any location, under his control, where segregated facilities are maintained. He certifies further that he will not maintain or provide for his employees any segregated facilities at any of his establishments, and that he will not permit his employees to perform their services at any location, under his control, where segregated facilities are maintained. The bidder, offer or, applicant, or subcontractor agrees that a breach of this certification is a violation of the Equal Opportunity clause in this contact. As used in this certificate, the term “segregated facilities” means any waiting rooms, work areas, rest rooms and wash rooms, restaurants and other eating areas, time clocks, locker rooms and other storage or dressing areas, parking lots, drinking fountains, recreation and entertainment areas, transportation, and housing facilities provided for employees which are segregated by explicit directive or are in fact segregated on the basis of race, creed, color, or national origin, because of habit, local custom, or otherwise. He further agrees that (except where he has obtained identical certifications from proposed subcontractors for specific time periods) he will obtain identical certifications from proposed subcontractors prior to the award of subcontract exceeding \$10,000 which are not exempt from the provisions of the Equal Opportunity clause; that he will retain such certifications in his files, and that he will forward the following notice to such proposed subcontractors (except where the proposed subcontractors have submitted identical certifications for specific time periods).

A five percent (%5) Bid Bond or certified cashier's check must accompany all bids. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

"DBE REQUIREMENTS"

Each Bidder must fully comply with the requirements, terms, and conditions as set forth in the contract documents to achieve Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation during the performance of this contract. The bidder commits itself to the program for DBE participation and all other requirements, terms, and conditions of the bid conditions by submitting a properly signed bid.

The bidder agrees to make "good faith efforts" to subcontract a portion of the total value of the contract to Disadvantaged businesses. This shall be done in compliance with the six (6) good faith efforts as outlined in 40 CFR 31.36(e). Failure to demonstrate good faith efforts may lead to the rejection of bids. For the purpose of this program, the term "subcontractor" includes all construction, modification, and service work contracted by the bidder in the execution of the work under this contract.
