ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Southwestern Hampshire County Water Extension** project will be received by the **Central Hampshire Public Service District** at their office located at **18540 Northwestern Pike, Augusta, WV 26704**, until **11:00 AM** local time on **June 13, 2023**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

Any contract or contracts awarded under this invitation for bids are expected to be funded in part by grants and loans from: US Department of Housing and Urban Development Small Cities Block Grant; West Virginia Infrastructure and Jobs Development Council. Neither the United States, the State of West Virginia nor any of their departments, agencies or employees are or will be a party to this invitation to bid or any resulting contract.

This construction of this project will also be funded in part with funds made available from the Federal Government through the US Army Corps of Engineers Section 571 program. Bidders must comply with all applicable laws and regulations for construction projects receiving Federal aid including, but not limited to, the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and the Davis-Bacon Act as amended.

The method of bidding will be as follows:

CONTRACT #1 – Water Line Extensions (Phase I &II):

Unit price contract to provide and install 46,020 LF 6-inch waterline; 3,260 LF of 4-inch waterline; 11,985 LF 3-inch PVC waterline; 10,455 LF 2-inch waterline; 940 LF of directional drills; 460 LF of highway bores; 713 LF of highway open cuts; 715 LF of stream crossings; 50 gate valves; 6 fire hydrants; 21 Air Release Assemblies; 12 Flushout Assemblies; 1 35 GPM booster station; and other work required to provide the complete system improvements project.

CONTRACT #2 – Water Storage Tank:

Lump sum contract to construct one (1) water storage tank measuring 20 feet in diameter by 21 feet in height to the overflow with a nominal volume of 50,000 gallons. Contract also includes access road and appurtenances to make a complete operating system .

There will be a MANDATORY pre-bid conference on **May 31, 2023 at 11:00 am** for all bidders located at: **Central Hampshire PSD Office Building** located at 18540 Northwestern Pike, Augusta, WV, **26704**.

If Contractor intends to let any subcontractors for a portion of the work, Contractor shall take affirmative steps to assure that small, minority and women’s businesses are used when possible as sources of supplies, equipment, construction, and services. Affirmative steps shall consist of: (1) including qualified small, minority and women’s businesses are used when possible as sources of supplies, equipment, construction, and services; (2) assuring that small, minority and women’s businesses are solicited whenever they are potential sources; (3) dividing total requirements when economically feasible, into small tasks or quantities to permit maximum participation of small, minority and women’s businesses; (4) establishing delivery schedules, where the requirements of the work permit, which will encourage participation by small, minority and women’s businesses; (5) using the services and assistance of the Small Business Administration and the Minority Business Development Agency of the U.S. Department of Commerce; (6) requiring each party to a subcontract to take the affirmative steps of this section; and (7) Contractor is encouraged to procure goods and services from labor surplus area firms.

By the submission of its bid, the bidder, offer or, applicant, or subcontractor certifies that he does not maintain or provide for his employees any segregated facilities at any of his establishments, and that he does not permit his employees to perform their services at any location, under his control, where segregated facilities are maintained. He certifies further that he will not maintain or provide for his employees any segregated facilities at any of his establishments, and that he will not permit his employees to perform their services at any location, under his control, where segregated facilities are maintained. The bidder, offer or, applicant, or subcontractor agrees that a breach of this certification is a violation of the Equal Opportunity clause in this contact. As used in this certificate, the term “segregated facilities” means any waiting rooms, work areas, rest rooms and wash rooms, restaurants and other eating areas, time clocks, locker rooms and other storage or dressing areas, parking lots,

drinking fountains, recreation and entertainment areas, transportation, and housing facilities provided for employees which are segregated by explicit directive or are in fact segregated on the basis of race, creed, color, or national origin, because of habit, local custom, or otherwise. He further agrees that (except where he has obtained identical certifications from proposed subcontractors for specific time periods) he will obtain identical certifications from proposed subcontractors prior to the award of subcontract exceeding \$10,000 which are not exempt from the provisions of the Equal Opportunity clause; that he will retain such certifications in his files, and that he will forward the following notice to such proposed subcontractors (except where the proposed subcontractors have submitted identical certifications for specific time periods).

HUD REQUIREMENTS

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and "HUD Section 109," which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin.

This Community Development Block Grant project is to be financed in part by a grant from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the West Virginia Development Office and will be referred to as the **Central Hampshire PSD Southwestern Hampshire County Water Extension**.

The work to be performed under this contract is subject to the requirements of Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended, 12 U.S.C. 1701 u (Section 3). The purpose of Section 3 is to ensure that employment and other economic opportunities generated by HUD assistance or HUD-assisted projects covered by Section 3, shall, to the greatest extent feasible, be directed to low- and very low-income persons, particularly persons who are recipients of HUD assistance for housing.

The contractor will ensure that to the greatest extent feasible opportunities for training and employment arising in connection with this CDBG-assisted project will be extended to lower income project area residents. Further, the contractor will, to the greatest extent feasible, utilize business concerns located in or substantially owned by residents of the project area, in the award of contracts and purchase of services and supplies.

The parties of this contract agree to comply with HUD's regulations in 24 CFR Part 135, which implement Section 3. Bidders' attention is directed to the Section 3 "Clause" set forth in the contract documents.

Bidders must comply with the requirements for Affirmative Action and Minority Business Enterprises participation as described in the Federal Specifications insert to the Contract Documents. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Copeland Act, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Act, and the West Virginia Division of Labor Wages for Construction of Public Improvements pursuant to West Virginia Code §21-5A-3.

US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS REQUIREMENTS

This construction of this project will be funded in part with funds made available from the Federal Government through the US Army Corps of Engineers Section 571 program. Bidders must comply with all applicable laws and regulations for construction projects receiving Federal aid including, but not

limited to, the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and the Davis-Bacon Act as amended.

A **five percent (%5) Bid Bond** or certified cashier's check must accompany all bids. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
