It is expected that the final addendum will be sent from the Office of the Engineer no later than February 23, 2012. It is therefore strongly encouraged that all Bidders submit any necessary requests for information several days prior to that date.

Method of Bidding will be as follows:

CONTRACT #1 - Elk Fork, Bens Run and Fluharty Addition Water Extensions: Unit price contract to construct approximately 44,602 LF of 6", 10,540 LF of 4", 5,416 LF of 2" waterline, 374 feet of highway borings, 1,410 feet of horizontal directional drilling, 48 valves, 10 fire hydrants, 8 flushout assemblies, 128 meters and meter settings, 2 tie-ins to existing mains, and other work required to provide a complete operating water system.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. Each Bidder must submit with his bid, security in the amount, form, and subject to the conditions provided for in the Information for Bidders. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Any Contractor submitting a Bid on this project hereby certifies, indicates, and acknowledges that he/she has a license and meets all the qualifications required by the statutes of the state and subdivision in which the work is to be performed. Bidders must comply with Article 21-11-11 of the West Virginia Code by including their contractor's license number on any bid submission.
