Method of Bidding will be as follows:

CONTRACT #1 - WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE:

Lump sum contract for construction of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade consisting of all work necessary to upgrade existing aerated facultative lagoon wastewater treatment plant; including constructing a shelter over the existing head works, installing blowers in a new shelter, constructing an ultraviolet disinfection channel and building, constructing a storage addition to the existing operations building, repairing the effluent valves, site piping, miscellaneous electrical work, renovating the existing buildings, demolishing an existing chlorine contact chamber, access road paving, landscaping and other incidental work required for a complete operating wastewater treatment plant.

CONTRACT #2 - LIFT STATION REHABILITATION, GRINDER PUMP REPLACEMENTS, AND SCADA SYSTEM:

Lump sum contract to rehabilitate four (4) existing Smith & Loveless lift stations (Stoops Road, Jackson Run, Bonnivale and Route 21); rehabilitate four (4) existing submersible lift stations (Benson, Meadowlands, Comfort Suites and Cracker Barrel); provide forty-five (45) complete grinder pump stations, including grinder pump basin, control pole and panel, electrical, reconnecting existing service line, and decommissioning existing pumps; provide three (3) grinder pump flood modifications; provide radio SCADA system including eleven (11) RTU at existing lift stations (I-77, Hampton Inn, Leigh Mason, and the eight (8) above), an MTU at the WWTP, and necessary radio, antennas, and accouterments.

CONTRACT #3 - WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM REHABILITATION:

Unit price contract to locate and raise 18 existing manhole castings, install approximately 12 new watertight manhole castings, approximately 200 vertical feet of internal manhole sealing, rebuilding 5 manhole inverts, sewer line root removal, approximately 2,100 LF of internal video inspection of sewer lines, construct approximately 427 LF of 8 inch force main, 3,159 LF of 8 inch gravity sewer, 1,555 LF of 4 inch and 6 inch service lines, 17 new manholes, 33 vertical feet of 48 inch riser pipe, 80 LF of highway borings, tie-ins to existing sewer lines, video taping of surface features and other appurtenances required to build a complete sewer system and complete rehabilitation of an existing gravity sewage collection system.

CONTRACT #4 - GRINDER PUMP CORES:

Unit price contract to furnish 70 grinder pump cores to the Owner.

- 2) Bid Bond (all Bid Bonds must be signed or countersigned by a West Virginia Agent).
- 3) Compliance Statement (Form RD400-6).
- 4) Certificate of Receipt of Addenda.
- 5) Certification regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility and Voluntary Exclusion - Lower Tier Covered Transactions (AD1048).
- 6) Certification for Contracts, Grants and Loans. (RD Instruction 1940-Q, Exhibit A-1).
- 7) State of West Virginia Drug Free Workplace Conformance Affidavit (WV Code Section 21-10-8).
- 8) West Virginia Contractors License No. (on Bid Form).

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. Each Bidder must submit with his Bid, security in the amount, form, and subject to the conditions provided for in the Information for Bidders. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Any Contractor submitting a Bid on this project hereby certifies, indicates, and acknowledges that he/she has a license and meets all the qualifications required by the statutes of the state and subdivision in which the work is to be performed. Bidders must comply with Article 21-11-11 of the West Virginia Code by including their contractor's license number on any bid submission.
